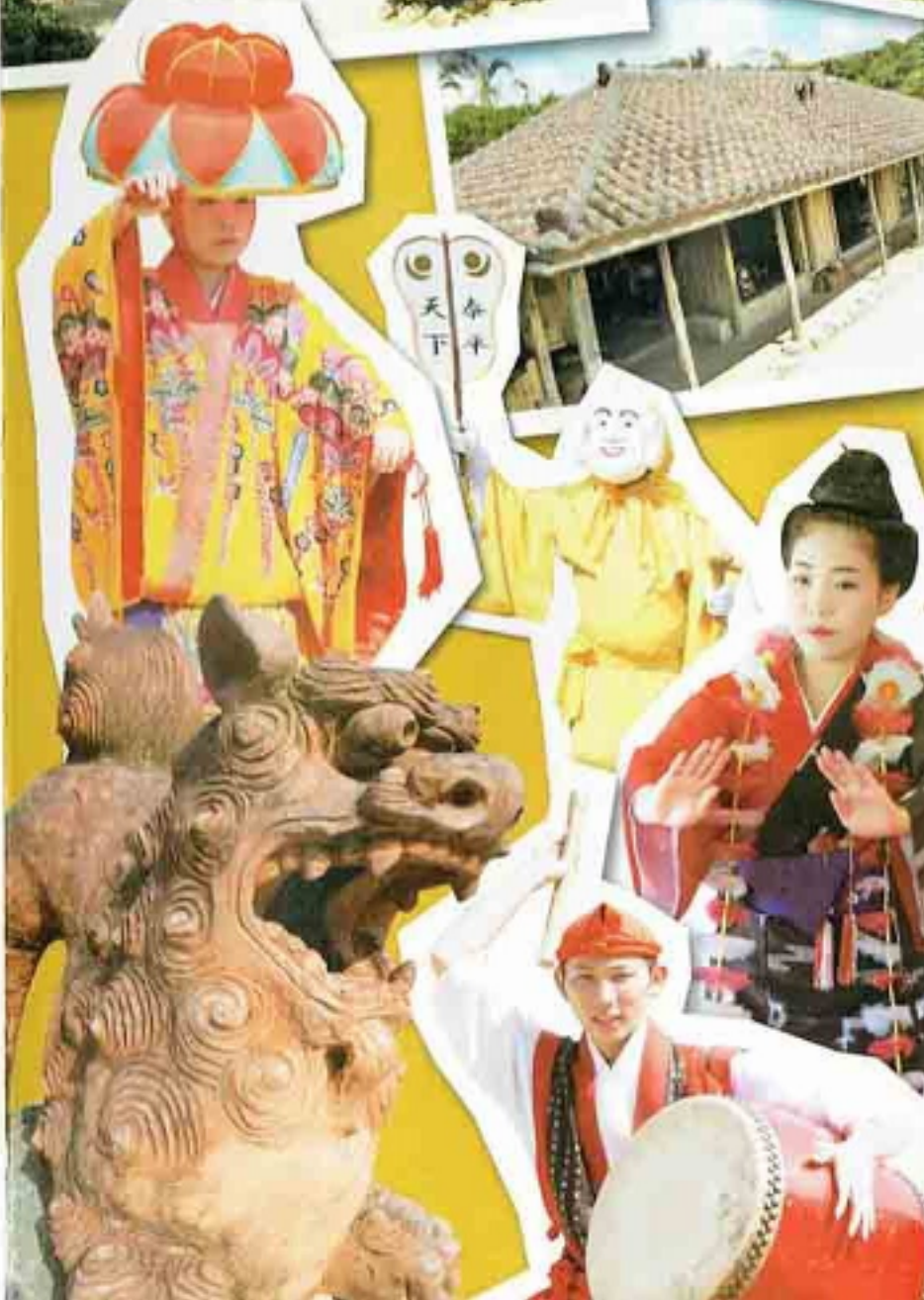

# Illustrated Ryukyu Mura Map

**1 Old Nakasone House (Built in 1808)**  
This common residential home was relocated from Zakumi, Yonitani Village.

**2 Old Kokuba House (Built in 1928)**  
This was the childhood home of Koutarou Kokubua, who drove Okinawa's post-war economic recovery.

**3 Old Tamanaha House (Built in 1893)**  
This common residential home was relocated from Shioya, Onna Village.

**4 Old Hirata House Furu (Built in 1898)**  
"Furu" is a type of pithy that was located inside in old residences.

**5 Old Hanashiro House (Built in 1888)**  
This common residential home was relocated from Nakazato Village, Kume (now Kunimejima) Town.

**6 Old Nishi Ishigaki House (Built in 1903)**  
This common residential home was relocated from Yaoyama, Ishigaki City.

**7 Old Shimabukuro House (Built in 1888)**  
Relocated from Haneji, Nago City, this residential home was built in the Meiji Era. Its owner is said to have been a successful farmer.

**8 Old Shimabukuro Residence Elevated Storehouse (Built in 1888)**  
This storehouse was used to store grains and other items long ago. At the time, it was a symbol of wealth.

**9 Old Higa House (Built in 1878)**  
Relocated from Hyakuna, Tamagusuku Village (now Nanjo City), this is the old home of the landlord of "Ukarujairiku," the birthplace of rice cultivation in Okinawa.

**10 Old Oshiro House (Built in 1808)**  
Relocated from Shuri, Naha City, this home was the residence of Uehkata Yonabara, a prominent retainer of the Ryukyu government.

**11 Pottery Workshop (Yachimun House)**  
Offers authentic pottery classes, wheel throwing and hand-forming classes, and Ryukyu ceramics (Yachimun) for sale.

**12 Sataya (Sugar Cane Mill)**  
Watch how sugar was made in the old days with a sugar cane mill powered by a water buffalo. Feel free to take pictures.

**13 Okinawa Station Chanpuru**  
The "Chanpuru Market" convention store located here carries Okinawa specialties, T-shirts, sweets, character goods, and more!

**14 Popo Shop**  
Enjoy handmade Okinawa-style crepes (Popo). The sugar cane (100%) juice is also popular!
